## Comments and Discussions (Vice President, Mr. Jake Porter)

- Jake mentioned he looks forward to learning more from each Board member on what they're doing and how he can best support them in their AFA WMC positions. Regarding how we make AFA WMC more relevant to Base and Community

- Better promoting AFA WMC's past involvement in the community
  - Published articles (targeted messaging), social media campaigns, or in-person presentations using testimonials as well as data visualization to better showcase the Chapter's impact/results, program support, volunteer hour, etc.
  - Picture Posters in the AFA Chalets at the Dayton Air Show depicted our past support (a picture can speak a thousand words)





- Better promoting AFA WMC's potential/future involvement in the community
  - Build better relationships with key stakeholders so they understand they AFA WMC is available to help them
  - Speak or participate at other organization events to promote how we can help as well as listen to what support is needed
  - Bringing the educational community (Superintendents, Principals, Teachers) to the Dayton Air Show/AFA Chalets to showcase how we can support STEM in their ecosystem
  - Create meaningful volunteer opportunities that allow people to contribute their skills and feel connected to AFA and/or the specific community support

## Regarding how to increase 'activism'

- Find out 'why' members joined
- Determine a member's willingness to be more active; and if so, identify their main interest areas of support
- VPs need must be prepared to specifically explain how a new volunteer's support can be utilized in a meaningful way then give the volunteer the tools and guidance to make that happen
- The Executive Council and all VPs must be prepared to explain the tangible and intangible benefits of becoming more involved in AFA and AFA WMC
